Daybreak Point Bible Camp Society is a non-profit volunteer society that runs twelve camps from June 29th through to September 29th for children and teens ages nine through nineteen. Each weekly camp is staffed by different groups of people, all who volunteer their time to come and serve at our camp (in fact they pay \$65 to come and work) in non-paid volunteer positions. We run a variety of activities such as sporting events, water skiing, canoeing and also provide Christian education. Our Staff must supervise children and young adults and, therefore, we take every precaution to ensure the safety of the campers.

Even though our camp is located on Anvil Island in Howe Sound, adjacent to Lions Bay, many of our campers come from the municipalities of the lower mainland including a significant number from the City of Surrey. Since we work with children, we require _____ (*volunteer staff member*) to obtain a Criminal Record Checks as they are in a position of authority over children.
